



Poster Competition For Children Ages 6 - 11

To celebrate Global Handwashing Day 2008, children ages 6 – 11 are invited to participate in a poster competition to promote handwashing with soap among school children.

Eligibility: The competition is designed for children who are enrolled at U.K. primary schools. Further eligibility criteria are listed in the competition rules and regulations.

Prize: One prize will be awarded in each age band (6 – 8 and 9 – 11). Each eligible winner and a designated parent or guardian will receive a one-week trip to India, sponsored by Unilever, to sightsee and visit Unilever Lifebuoy's Swasthya Chetna handwashing promotion sites. The Swasthya Chetna programme has reached more than 100 million people in rural India and won several prizes, including the postal award by the Government of India, which has never been awarded to a brand in more than 60 years.

Deadline: The deadline is midnight (GMT), November 14th, 2008.

How to enter: Posters must be A4 in size and promote handwashing with soap, through images and text, along with one of the sub-themes:

- before eating
- after using the toilet, or
- promoting health.

Entries must be in accordance with the Conditions of Entry to be eligible.
